Compensation: Starts at \$30/hr of instructional time and goes up DOE and seniority. Training and Optional Admin hours will be paid out at \$18/hr.

JOB DUTIES:

- Implement Creative Space Katy-branded curricula through in-person and virtual classes/workshops/productions solo or as part of a team.
- Collaborate with staff to create, refine, and implement curricula based upon ongoing assessment of classroom efficacy.
- Maintain a safe, well-managed learning environment with clear expectations of students.
- Work closely with partners to achieve goals and learning outcomes.
- Proactively communicate with Program Managers regarding scheduling and other needs.
- Attend mandatory training and demonstrate an openness to coaching and feedback.
- Represent Creative Space Katy in a professional and informed manner.

In addition to the duties listed above, the Creative Space Katy expects the following of each employee: adheres to theatre's policies and procedures; works in a safe manner; performs duties as workload necessitates; maintains a positive and respectful attitude; communicates regularly with supervisor about department issues; demonstrates efficient time management and prioritizes workload; demonstrates regular and consistent attendance and punctuality; meets department productivity standards; participates in Theatre events as needed or required; and completes other duties as assigned.

REQUIREMENTS (SKILLS and KNOWLEDGE):

- Bachelor's degree (or comparable training/professional experience) in at least one of the following disciplines: Dance, Music, Theatre or Theatre Education.
- Exceptional skills and/or lived experience in at least one of the following areas:
 - Acting – including direction, improvisation, classical, and physical theatre.
 - Dancing - Ballet, Tap, Jazz, and various styles of Musical Theatre Appreciation
 - Music - particularly voice. Music Direction, vocal coaching, and private lessons.
- 3+ Years of Relevant Experience as a Teaching Artist
- Ability to work a varied, part-time schedule year-round as needed. Classes will be taught in semester or year-long format.
- Strong classroom management skills rooted in positive behavior reinforcements.
- Ability to maintain confidential information
- Exhibits a positive attitude with good communication and interpersonal skills.
- (Preferred) Ability to work with and mentor emergent teaching artists in their craft.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS/WORKING CONDITIONS:

- Reliable transportation and the ability to travel to the studio in Katy Tx.
- Ability to lift and move 25 lbs.
- Typical hours are in the afternoons, after the school day, or on the weekends, with occasional training scheduled.
- Additional hours paid out at the admin rate may be available throughout the year on a first-come basis.
